**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19 BORDER CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) (No. 3)
REGULATIONS, 2020**

Regulations made by the Governor under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act, R.S.A. c. E45

Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, principal Regulations means the Emergency Powers (Covid-19 Border Control) Regulations, 2020 (R.A.11/2020).

Amendment of section 1

2. The principal Regulations is amended in section 1 by deleting the definition of “specified period” and substituting with the following—

“specified period” means the period from 1 June to 30 June 2020.

Substitution of section 3

3. The principal Regulations is amended by repealing section 3 and substituting the following—

“Prohibition of the operation of Vessels in Anguilla Waters

3. (1) No vessels shall operate in Anguilla waters during the specified period.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to vessels—

(a) licensed to transport cargo;

(b) used for emergency services or for the transportation of emergency personnel or equipment;

(c) vessels used for the purpose of fishing in accordance with subsections (3) and (4)(b); or

(d) vessels or boats used for passenger transportation in accordance with section 2(2)(c) of the Public Health (Temporary Closure of Ports) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.

(3) A vessel used for fishing is prohibited from operating in the southern territorial waters of Anguilla.

(4) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) the Commissioner of Police, may grant written permission to—

(a) the owner or captain of a vessel to operate in Anguilla waters; or

(b) the owner or captain of a vessel used for fishing, to operate in the southern territorial waters of Anguilla

subject to conditions as may be imposed by the Commissioner.

(5) Vessels referred to in subsections 4 and 2(c) shall only operate in Anguilla waters between the hours of 5am to 6pm.”

Citation and Commencement

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (COVID-19 Border Control) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2020 and shall come into force on 1 June 2020.
