## EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19 BORDER CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) (No. 3) REGULATIONS, 2020

Regulations made by the Governor under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act, R.S.A. c. E45

## Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, principal Regulations means the Emergency Powers (Covid-19 Border Control) Regulations, 2020 (R.A.11/2020).

#### Amendment of section 1

2. The principal Regulations is amended in section 1 by deleting the definition of "specified period" and substituting with the following—

#### Substitution of section 3

3. The principal Regulations is amended by repealing section 3 and substituting the following—

### "Prohibition of the operation of Vessels in Anguilla Waters

- 3. (1) No vessels shall operate in Anguilla waters during the specified period.
  - (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to vessels—
    - (a) licensed to transport cargo;
    - (b) used for emergency services or for the transportation of emergency personnel or equipment;
    - (c) vessels used for the purpose of fishing in accordance with subsections (3) and (4)(b); or
    - (d) vessels or boats used for passenger transportation in accordance with section 2(2)(c) of the Public Health (Temporary Closure of Ports) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.
  - (3) A vessel used for fishing is prohibited from operating in the southern territorial waters of Anguilla.
  - (4) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) the Commissioner of Police, may grant written permission to—
    - (a) the owner or captain of a vessel to operate in Anguilla waters; or
    - (b) the owner or captain of a vessel used for fishing, to operate in the southern territorial waters of Anguilla

subject to conditions as may be imposed by the Commissioner.

(5) Vessels referred to in subsections 4 and 2(c) shall only operate in Anguilla waters between the hours of 5am to 6pm."

<sup>&</sup>quot;specified period" means the period from 1 June to 30 June 2020.

### Citation and Commencement

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (COVID-19 Border Control) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2020 and shall come into force on 1 June 2020.
