**PUBLIC HEALTH (TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTS) (AMENDMENT) (NO.3)
REGULATIONS, 2020**

Regulations made by the Minister with approval of Executive Council under section 8 of the Public Health Act, R.S.A. c. P125.

Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, “principal Regulations” means the Public Health (Temporary Closure of Ports) Regulations, 2020 (R.A. 49/2020).

Amendment of section 1

2. The principal Regulations is amended in section 1 by deleting the definition of specified period and substituting the following—

“specified period” means 31 July 2020 to 31 October 2020.”.

Amendment of section 2

3. The principal Regulations is amended in section 2 by deleting subsection (2) and substituting with the following—

“(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to—

- (a) aircrafts, ships, vessels or boats licensed for the transportation of Cargo;
- (b) aircrafts, ships, vessels or boats used for emergency services or for the transportation of emergency personnel or equipment;
- (c) aircrafts, ships, vessels or boats used for the—
 - (i) repatriation of Anguillan citizens to Anguilla, and
 - (ii) departure of Anguillan and Non-Anguillan citizens from Anguilla;

as specified in Executive Council Minutes 20/238 of 25 May 2020; and

- (d) aircrafts, ships, vessels or boats used for the transportation of persons to whom authorisation to travel to Anguilla has been given pursuant to Quarantine (COVID)(Arriving Passengers Health Clearance) Rules, 2020.”.

Citation and commencement

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Temporary Closure of Ports) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2020 and shall come into force on 31 July 2020.
