## PUBLIC HEALTH ACT R.S.A. C. P125

**PUBLIC HEALTH (QUARANTINE) (COVID-19) (AMENDMENT) (NO 3) REGULATIONS, 2021**

Regulations made by the Minister with approval of the Executive Council under section 8(c) of the Public Health Act, R.S.A. c. P125.

**Interpretation**

1. In these Regulations “the principal Regulations” means the Public Health (Quarantine) (COVID-19) Regulations, 2020.

**Amendment to section 8**

2. The principal Regulations are amended in subsection (2)—

(a) by deleting paragraph (a) and substituting the following—

“(a) where the Quarantine Authority deems the home or private accommodation to be suitable for isolation or quarantining, the person shall be eligible for mandatory quarantining or isolation at home or at a private accommodation for—

(i) at least 10 days where such person has not received a COVID-19 vaccination in accordance with the Quarantine (COVID) (Arriving Passengers Health Clearance) Rules, 2020, and

(ii) at least 7 days where such person has received a COVID-19 vaccination in accordance with the Quarantine (COVID) (Arriving Passengers Health Clearance) Rules, 2020;”.

(b) by deleting (4)(a) and substituting the following—

(a) quarantine for a period of –

(i) not less than 10 days where such person has not received a COVID-19 vaccination, and

(ii) not less than 7 days where such person has received a COVID-19 vaccination;

(c) by inserting the following new subsection after subsection (5)—

“(5a) A person shall be deemed to have received a COVID-19 vaccination for the purpose of this section if he has received the COVID-19 vaccination in full where at least 21 days have passed since the final dose of such vaccination was administered.”.

**Amendment of section 11**

3. The principal Regulations are amended in section 11 by deleting the phrase “17 April 2021” and substituting the phrase “30 April 2021”.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Quarantine) (COVID-19) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2021.
