**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19 BORDER CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) (No. 6)
REGULATIONS, 2021**

Regulations made by the Governor under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act, R.S.A. c. E45

Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, principal Regulations means the Emergency Powers (Covid-19 Border Control) Regulations, 2020 (R.A.11/2020).

Replacement of section 3

2. The principal Regulations is amended by repealing section 3 and replaced the following—

“Prohibition of the operation of Vessels in Anguilla Waters

3. (1) No vessels shall operate in Anguilla waters during the specified period.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to vessels—

(a) licensed to transport cargo;

(b) used for emergency services or for the transportation of emergency personnel or equipment;

(c) vessels used for the purpose of fishing in accordance with subsections (3) (4) and (5); or

(d) vessels or boats used for passenger transportation in accordance with section 2(2) of the Public Health (COVID-19 Regulation of Ports) Regulations, 2020 (93/2020).

(3) A vessel licensed for fishing is permitted to operate in the northern territorial waters of Anguilla where such vessel is equipped with a GPS tracker.

(4) Where a vessel licensed for fishing wishes to operate in the southern territorial waters of Anguilla permission must granted by the Commissioner of Police under subsection (5)(b).

(5) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) the Commissioner of Police, may grant written permission to—

(a) the owner or captain of a vessel to operate in Anguilla waters; or

(b) the owner or captain of a vessel licensed for fishing to operate in the southern territorial waters of Anguilla;

(c) the owner or captain of a vessel licensed for fishing but not equipped with a GPS tracker, to operate in the northern territorial waters of Anguilla

subject to conditions as may be imposed by the Commissioner.


(6) Where permission to operate is required under these Regulations, the owner or captain of such vessel shall not operate in Anguilla waters, unless such permission is granted.

(7) A person who breaches subsection (8) commits an offence.”

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (COVID-19 Border Control) (Amendment) (No. 6) Regulations, 2021.
